Euphoric Learning Experience..... A humble beginning.

The school building came up in two phases with the foundation stone laid by Dr. (Smt.) D. Purandareswari, the then Union Minister for Human Resource Development and the inauguration of the Primary Block (Block-A) by Shri Anil R.Dave, the then Chief Justice of High Court of Andhra Pradesh on 4th July, 2009. The second phase came in the form of the Secondary block (Block-B), which was inaugurated on 16th April, 2011 by His Excellency Shri ESL Narasimhan, Joint Governor of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. Initially the school was started from Pre-primary to class-V and over its span of 10 years, it has grown to the level of Pre-primary to class-XII with the pupil's strength of around 2100, and with over 85 teaching and non-teaching staff. However, the school is expanding both in terms of student and teaching fraternity year after year.





Kulapati K M Munshi

As a young man, Kanhaiyalal Maneklal Munshi was imbued with a sense of India's greatness. Not yet out of his teens, he learnt from his mother's songs and stories about the sages and seers of India's past.

Like most others of his generation and class, Munshi took to the study of law and rose to the pinnacle of his profession even in the era of legal giants. It was but natural that law led to politics and politics to the service of the country's heritage. The call of Mahatma Gandhi for sacrifice led to Munshi bidding goodbye to his lucrative practice and prepared to risk his all in the fight against injustice to his country.

He regarded India's independence in 1947 as an opportunity for an ascent once again. He believed that the people of India had the gift of idealism and realism in them to climb up into a new millennium. Munshi showed that a man with pride in the past could also have faith in the future through the instruments of science and technology. Today when the world is so conscious of the environment and of ecological factors, it is edifying to note that as much as half a century ago, Munshi's Vanamahotsava scheme heralded the impulse for preserving ecology. Munshi's vision was as deep as it was vast.

Munshi was keen to set in motion ongoing constructive measures to foster and strengthen the creative, cultural and educational foundations of the Indian Nation with the active participation of the citizens from all castes, communities and regions through broad based selfless, voluntary, totally apolitical organization supported by the goodwill and co-operation of the government. Therefore, Munshi conceived of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan in 1937, a decade before the advent of Independence.

Towards this end, Munshi, with the blessings of Mahatma Gandhi and active support and co-operation of serveral eminent leaders founded the Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan as a national organization, nay, movement, with an international outlook. This was in 1938.

The Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan was officially registered on November 7, 1938.

Our infrastructure is endowed with well planned, ventilated class rooms and spacious corridors that facilitates free movement of the children, also provided with separate labs for physics, chemistry, biology and math. The school also has a multipurpose hall, well equipped audio visual room, computer science labs for primary and secondary classes.

School Canteen

The school canteen caters to the need of the students by providing nutritious snacks and lunch at affordable rates.

School Transport

Transport facilities are available for the students from different parts of the city. The charges depend upon the distance between the school and the alighting points

SMS Alerts

The school will send important and urgent information like sudden declaration of a holiday, change in examination schedule etc. through SMS alerts to the parents on their mobiles. The recent addition to the infrastructural facilities is Fitness Corner Amphitheatre, Football Ground, Basketball-cum-Skating Court and Cricket Practicing Net.















Computer Lab:

The school has a separate computer lab for the primary and senior block. The Lab is centrally air-conditioned and provided with Internet facility. Students are permitted to use it under the supervision of the teachers. Resource Rooms in the school are well equipped with audio/video facility, L.C.D projector screens etc. Teaching-Learning is made interactive through the use of television, video, audio/video C.Ds.

Smart Board Equipped Classrooms:

In order to make the teaching / learning process interesting and innovative each classroom from Class VI to Class XII, is equipped with a smart board where in the teachers corelate the day to day academics with audio-visuals incorporating the CBSE syllabus and giving a wide range of learning experiences to the students.

School Library:

To facilitate reading, the school has separate Library sections for Primary and Senior blocks. The evergrowing computerised school library is the knowledge hub of all academic activities. The vast collection of books in English, Hindi and Telugu includes classics, fiction, self-help books, educational magazines, books and journals on science and technology, history and culture. The school also subscribes to local and national dailies in English, Hindi and Telugu. To inculcate good reading habits each class from classes LKG to Class V has been provided with its own Class Library stocked with books suited to its age and level.

Amphitheater:

An exclusive place to organize literary activities like quiz/debate/role play etc.

PRE-PRIMARY:

Bhavan's Pre-primary section focuses on activity oriented teaching method through role-play, dances and songs to help children learn the concepts. A child in the Pre-primary is assessed by the teacher on day-to-day basis which helps the child in fine motor development and in stimulating and enriching physical & social environment.

Graduation :

Graduation ceremony is organised on the completion of Upper Kindergarten and certificates are awarded to the tiny tots.

Classes I to V :

The XSEED curriculum for the primary raises the student performance and builds quality in teaching inside classrooms. The basic core subjects are English, Math, Science, Social Science, Hindi / Telugu and Computer Technology.

Apart from the regular core subjects, a wide variety of work education gives opportunity for students to nurture their talents. All festivals and special events are celebrated traditionally to reach our objectives.

Classes VI to X:

The curriculum is laid down as per CBSE norms. The basic core subjects are English, Math, Science, Social Sciences, Hindi/ Telugu / Sanskrit and Computer Technology.

Assessment for Senior Secondary School.

The school follows a uniform system of evaluation pattern for classes IX to XII as per CBSE guidelnes. Students of class XII appear for All India Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) at the end of the academic year.





The Academic Platter ASSESSMENT

Primary: The students are evaluated by school based assessment that covers all the aspects of a student's overall development.

Middle & Secondary School : The school follows a uniform system of evaluation pattern for classes VI to X. as per CBSE guidelines. Students of class X appear for All India Secondary School Examination (AISSE) at the end of the academic year.

Facilitators

The teaching faculty of the school comprises of well qualified and experienced teachers with proven competence in their respective subjects. They work as a team and put in their maximum efforts towards realization of objectives, both of their profession and the institution.

The school, in turn, conducts orientation programmes and workshops to keep them abreast with the demands of contemporary education.

School Counsellor

The school extends the facility of a Counselor who is available on every Monday for consultation to help both the parents and the students.

Medical Practitioner

A qualified medical practitioner is available in the School on every alternate Mondays during school hours to facilitate medical advice to the students and staff.









Morning Assembly

The school begins its day with the morning assembly, which presents a picture of solemnity and discipline. Led by the prayer choir, the students sing devotional songs, the Bhavan's prayer every day and the Sarvadharma prayer on every Monday and Friday. Recitations, General quizzing, interesting science related activities, moral stories, celebrations of national and religious festivals and sloka recitation are an integral part of the assembly everyday.

Meditation

After the sloka recitation, the students meditate for five minutes every day.

Bhavan's Anthem

Learning Berond Classoom To imbibe the spirit of Bhavan's faith and to foster the fundamental values of our culture such as Rita, Satya, Yagna and Tapas the students of our school sing Bhavan's Anthem at the end of Morning Assembly on every Monday and Friday.

Sports& Games

Apart from academics the school lays special emphasis on various games and co-curricular activities. Students are encouraged, guided and assisted towards active participation in games.Some of our popular games are Athletics, Badminton, Basket Ball, Cricket, Foot Ball, Gymnastics, Kabbadi, Table Tennis, Tenicoit, Karate, Taekwondo and Kho-Kho.





Work Education

Creativity Unleashed

A variety of work education activities are planned and taught to students. They include Origami, Sketching, Bhagavad Gita Recitation, Debate, Declamation, Elocution, Conversation in various language clubs, Science based projects and experiments. Needle work, Maths club and many more.

Excursions and Educational Tours

Tours to places of educational interests are regularly organized right from the pre-primary level enabling every student to learn from his/her outdoor experiences.

Community Services

The school involves students in various community service programmes such as Swachh Bharath, Swachata Pakhwada, Environmental awareness, Road safety week, Run for unity, Joy of Giving week, visit to or phanages, hospitals and home for the aged. The students learn to share their joy and care for the needy.

Health Care

Regular health camps are organised to keep track of every student's health emphasizing more on eye-care and dental care.

Dance & Music

The students evincing interests in Art, Artifacts, Classical Music, Interactive Sessions, Film Making etc. are given ample opportunity to showcase their talents and varied interests through exposure to related programmes without deviating from the set goal of revitalizing Indian culture.

School Band: Students of school band are trained by a professional trainer on every Monday.



ADMISSIONS

- Registration for admissions into L.K.G begin in the month of January for the academic year beginning from April. Age accepted for admission into L.K.G is 3 plus as on 31st May. An authentic certificate of Date of Birth is an essential requirement at the time of registration.
- Schedule regarding admissions to classes, other than L.K.G will be updated on the school Notice Board in the month of March.
- iii) Admission forms will be issued subject to the availability of the vacancies in the respective classes.
- iv) Parents should fill in the application forms with utmost accuracy. No subsequent changes will be permitted for any reason whatsoever. (Details for Board Registrations for classes-IX, X, XI and XII will be made as per the data provided in Birth Certificate and admission application form).
- v) At the time of admission a student who attended a recognized school earlier must submit a Transfer Certificate issued by the earlier school. In case of students migrating from other states the transfer certificate must be countersigned by the concerned District Inspector of schools of the respective State/Regional Officer CBSE from where the student has migrated. (Details for CBSE Board Registrations will be made from the entries made in the Transfer Certificate only)
- vi) Candidates belonging to other categories i.e. B.C/S.C/S.T/minority etc., should submit authentic caste certificate at the time of Registration.
- vii) Students seeking admission into class-IX must produce a certificate that they have studied any two Indian languages in addition to English.
- viii) The decision of the school authorities regarding admission is final and binding.



Mode of Payments

- Out station cheques will not be accepted.
- All fee is payable in advance.
- The last date for payment of fees is 20th of first month of quarter i.e. April, August and December.
- If the fee is not paid on or before the due date, the following amount will be collected as late fee:
- Rs.50/- per day for 15 days after the last date.
- Rs. 100/- thereafter for every 30 days.
- If the fee with fine is not paid by the end of the quarter, the pupil's name will be struck off from the school rolls. The students will be readmitted only after obtaining written permission from the Principal and payment of fee of Rs.2,000/- for re-admission, if vacancy is available.
- Fee challan will be supplied to every student in advance by the Accounts Department, Cheques encashable locally only are accepted.
- Cheques for fees duly crossed should be drawn in favour of BHARATIYA VIDYA BHAVAN'S ATMAKURI RAMA RAO SCHOOL, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad.
- The date of realization of the cheque will be treated as date of payment. If the cheque is dishonoured and payment is not made before the due date, late fee will be charged as prescribed. Additional amount of Rs.50/- will be collected for dishonoured cheques.
- Parents will retain their copy of the fee challan with them and produce it as and when required by the Accounts Department for verification.
- Parents have the option of depositing the fee for the whole year in advance if they find it more convenient.
- For the first 20 days in every quarter, the HDFC bank
 Extension counter will be open in the school

- campus, from 10:00a.m. to 1:30p.m.
- Fees once paid will not be refunded.
